Each applicant must take the morning College Entrance Examination known as the Scholastic Aptitude Test no later than March of his senior year. Such test may be taken earlier. In the event the test is taken more than once the higher score will be used. All scholarship applications must be completed and filed with the Union by May 1st in which the applicant graduates from High School.

The Scholarship award shall be in the amount **1,875.00** per year for four years.

A total of **7,500.00** provided the student to whom the scholarship is awarded legitimately attends a bona fide college or university during such four-year period.

Important Notice
Please read this very carefully.
It is Important if you have any grandchildren.

In our effort to make improvements wherever possible we have made some changes, to the eligibility requirements for the grandchild scholarship award. I will explain the reasons why and then explain what these changes will mean to you. Under the old rules, when a club member in good standing dies, his or her grandchildren were no longer eligible for a scholarship award. Under the new rules, a deceased member's grandchild will remain eligible for the award if the member was in good standing at the time of his or her death. For a grandchild to be eligible, **YOU MUST HAVE RETIRED FROM LOCAL 707** and your dues in the retirees club must be paid before February 28 of the prior year. I.e. for a grandchild to be eligible for the 2003 award, your dues must be paid before February 29, 2002. The application deadline will be May 1 of each calendar year. If the rules sound complicated, I will clarify it to the simplest form. If you pay your dues in December or January or February each year, you will always be covered for the grandchild award. A member is defined as being in good standing when his or her dues are paid 12 consecutive months preceding the deadline of February 28. I used the date of 2003 as an example because that is the date when these rules will be implemented. The reason for this is so all retirees have the chance to join the club and be eligible. I feel to implement these new rules every retiree should understand the requirements. I used the term all retirees because this December newsletter is sent to all retirees, including those who are not a club member. Everyone can now join before it is too late. Please use the cut out in this letter when sending your dues. If you are a new member, the 12 consecutive months' membership has been waived for the year 2002, **ONLY** and your grandchild will be eligible. Any dues received after February 28, 2002, will make your grandchild **NOT** eligible. Please pay your dues on time so no problems occur. We have been able to secure this improvement so everyone has a chance to help a grandchild even after death. Your only obligation is to pay your dues on time. The problem that existed with the phone has been corrected and just press 0 for operator when calling and you will get Joyce the operator to help with your call. You can reach me on Wednesday, the same way by pressing 0 for operator.

The James R. Hoffa scholarship is also available to retirees and should be applied for. Eligibility requirements and forms can be obtained by calling the union hall or they can be downloaded from the website <http://www.teamster.org> The deadline for this scholarship is March 29, 2002. Remember it is your responsibility to get the application and to follow the rules.
